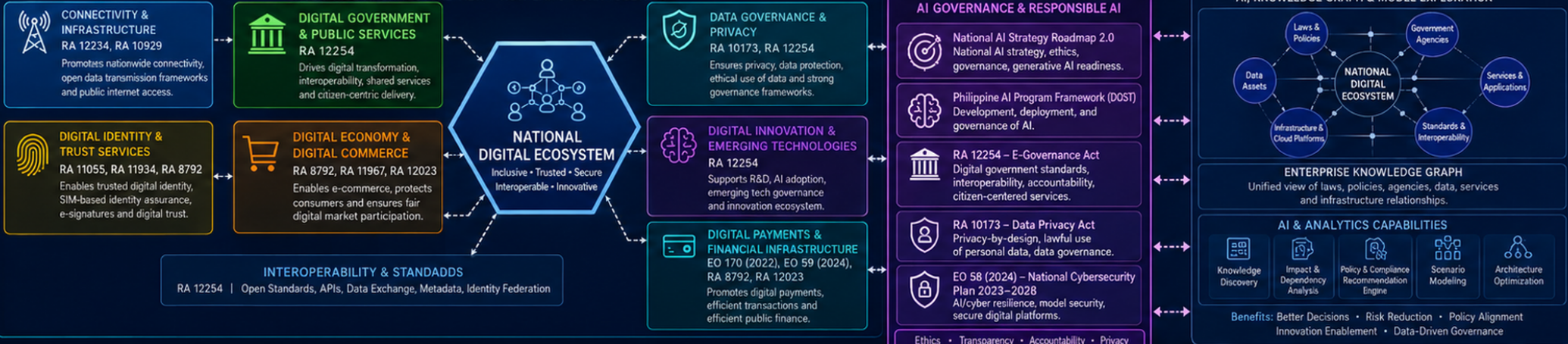

LEGAL FOUNDATION LAYER Key Republic Acts & Executive Orders shaping DICT and the Philippine Digital Ecosystem

FOUNDATIONAL	DICT ACT OF 2015 RA 10844 Establishes DICT as the primary ICT policy, planning, coordinating and implementing agency of the Executive Branch.	E-GOVERNANCE ACT RA 12254 Institutionalizes e-Governance, interoperability, ICT standards, data governance and digital transformation in government.	CONNECTIVITY ACT RA 12234 Establishes a comprehensive data transmission and connectivity framework and strengthens DICT & NTC roles.	E-COMMERCE ACT RA 8792 Recognizes electronic documents, e-signatures and e-transactions; enables digital commerce.	DATA PRIVACY ACT RA 10173 Protects personal information in government & private sector systems; promotes privacy by design and accountability.	PHILIPPINE ID SYSTEM ACT RA 11055 Creates the national digital identity foundation for secure and seamless transactions across sectors.
	FREE INTERNET ACCESS IN PUBLIC PLACES ACT RA 10929 Mandates free internet access in public places nationwide.	SIM REGISTRATION ACT RA 11934 Requires SIM registration to improve security, accountability and digital service delivery.	INTERNET TRANSACTIONS ACT RA 11967 Regulates internet transactions, online platforms and digital consumer protection.	VAT ON DIGITAL SERVICES RA 12023 Provides tax framework for non-resident digital service providers & digital transactions.	EXECUTIVE ORDER 58 (2024) National Cybersecurity Plan 2023-2028 Adopts the NCP and directs DICT to lead implementation, monitoring and review.	EXECUTIVE ORDER 170 (2022) Digital Payments for Government Directs the adoption of digital payments for government collections & disbursements.
EXECUTIVE ORDER 59 (2024) Streamlining Digital Government Payments / Transactions Further streamlines digital government transactions and e-commerce related processes.
